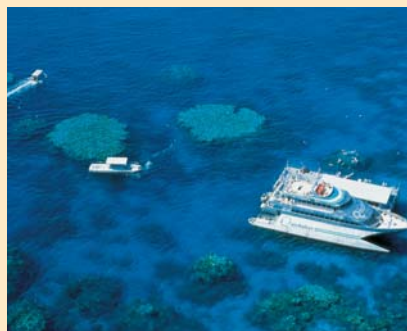
THE AUSSIE EXPLORER

Suggested itinerary

- DAY 1 IN FLIGHT/DEPARTURE DAY**

- DAY 13 SYDNEY**
A free day. Maybe view the huge variety of marine life that the country has to offer at the Sydney Aquarium or take a ferry ride from Sydney Harbour to Manly and relax on the beach.
- DAY 14 SYDNEY**
Match Day 4
Match followed by after match function.
- DAY 15 SYDNEY/CAIRNS**
Transfer to airport for your flight to Cairns. On arrival, transfer to your resort for five nights. Spend the remainder of the day enjoying the resort's facilities.
- DAY 16 CAIRNS**

- DAY 17 CAIRNS**

Today enjoy an exciting excursion to the Great Barrier Reef, with a chance to scuba dive or snorkel and visit the underwater world that is a dazzling kaleidoscope of colour and life.
