CANADIAN EXPEDITION

Suggested itinerary

DAY 1 DEPARTURE DAY/NIAGARA

Meet at the airport for your flight to Toronto. A Gullivers Sports Travel representative will be on hand to assist with check-in. DAY 3 NIAGARA/TORONTO

This morning jump on the Whirlpool Jet Boat on Niagara Gorge and travel along the white water of Devils Hole Rapids. In the afternoon transfer to Toronto for the next four nights. In the evening watch the Toronto Blue Jays in a Major League baseball fixture at the Rogers Centre.

DAY 4 TORONTO

Full day at leisure. Spend a day at Paramount Canada's Wonderland.



DAY 5 TORONTO

Match Day 2

This morning take a trip up the famous CN Tower and afterwards enjoy a tour of the Rogers Centre. Afternoon match followed by after match function.

DAY 6 TORONTO

Full day at leisure. Take a Hippo Tour of the city, which combines both a land and water tour of Toronto to see all the sights. In the evening watch the Toronto Marlies in an American Hockey League fixture at the Ricoh Coliseum.



DAY 7 TORONTO/FERGUS

Transfer to Fergus for the next two nights. Spend the rest of the day at leisure and relaxing on the beach.

DAY 8 FERGUS

DAY 9 TORONTO/IN FLIGHT

Transfer to Pearson International Airport for your flight home.
