

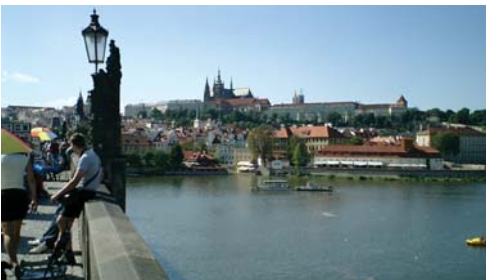


Czech Republic

THE GOLDEN CITY

Suggested itinerary

- DAY 1 DEPARTURE DAY**
Meet at the airport for your flight to Prague. On arrival transfer to your hotel in Prague for four nights. Spend the rest of the day relaxing and finding your bearings.
- DAY 2 PRAGUE**
Match Day 1
This morning is at leisure so you could visit the Old Town with its famous clock or the remarkable Old Jewish Cemetery. Afternoon match followed by after match function.
- DAY 3 PRAGUE**
A full day sightseeing. Perhaps take a conducted tour to the magnificent Prague Castle, the largest ancient castle in the world. Stroll over the famous Charles Bridge, passing street musicians who line the bridge, and spend the evening at one of the many concerts or theatres.



- DAY 4 PRAGUE**
Match Day 2
A free morning to possibly visit a beer cellar and shop for souvenirs. Alternatively, take a boat trip on the river. Afternoon match followed by refreshments.
- DAY 5 PRAGUE/HOME**
Your final morning at leisure and last chance to look around and buy souvenirs. This afternoon transfer to the airport for your flight home.

POLAND

Poland is one of the fastest developing countries in Europe, and with so many links to the UK, it makes an excellent value for money destination. The capital Warsaw allows football and rugby teams to combine playing competitive fixtures in their chosen sport with rich cultural heritage and many museums and architecture to enjoy. For the more adventurous activities such as paintballing and go karting can also be arranged.



Suggested itinerary

- DAY 1 DEPARTURE DAY**
Meet at the airport for your flight to Warsaw. On arrival transfer to your hotel in Warsaw for the next three nights. Rest of day at leisure to familiarise yourself with your surroundings.
- Day 2 WARSAW**
Match Day
Morning at leisure. Afternoon match followed by after match function. Activities can be arranged for the evening if required.
- Day 3 WARSAW**
Free day for optional sightseeing or activities – visit the Holocaust Museum, the old square or Gullivers can arrange paintballing or go karting
- Day 4 WARSAW/HOME**
Morning transfer back to the airport for your flight home.
