IRISH CHARM

Suggested itinerary 1 *Dublin*

DAY 1 DEPARTURE DAY

Transfer by executive coach to Holyhead from your selected pick-up point and catch the ferry to Dublin Bay. On arrival transfer to your hostel in Dublin for three nights. Spend the rest of the day exploring and settling in.

DAY 2 DUBLIN

Match Day 1

Spend this morning sightseeing. Perhaps take a guided tour of this vibrant city to see the famous sights such as Trinity College, St Stephens Green, Guinness Storehouse and O'Connell Street. Afternoon match followed by after match function.

DAY 3 DUBLIN

Match Day 2

A free morning to maybe visit the fascinating Dublinia in Christchurch and experience life in the Middle Ages at first hand in this reconstructed medieval town. Afternoon match followed by after match function.

DAY 4 DUBLIN/HOME

Coach transfer to Dublin Bay to catch the ferry to Holyhead, then onwards to your UK destination.



Suggested itinerary 2 *Cork/Dublin*

DAY 1 DEPARTURE DAY

Transfer to Pembroke by executive coach from selected pick-up point and catch the ferry to Rosslare. On arrival transfer to your accommodation in Cork for three nights.

DAY 2 CORK

A full day at leisure. Perhaps take an excursion to Blarney Castle and kiss the famous Blarney Stone to receive the gift of eloquence. Alternatively, a training session can be arranged at a local club.

DAY 3 CORK

Match Day 1

Spend the morning maybe visiting the exciting Royal Gunpowder Mills, where the manufacture of gunpowder took place from 1794 to 1903. Afternoon match followed by after match function.

DAY 4 CORK/DUBLIN

Transfer to your accommodation in Dublin for three nights.

DAY 5 DUBLIN

Match Day 2

Spend this morning exploring Dublin. Maybe take an architectural tour of Trinity College or stroll through the cathedrals and quays in Old Dublin. Afternoon match followed by after match function.

DAY 6 DUBLIN

Full day at leisure, so why not take a Viking Splash Tour on the River through the city? Alternatively, take a guided tour of the city visiting famous sights such as Dublin Castle and Christchurch Cathedral.

DAY 7 DUBLIN/HOME

Coach transfer to Dublin Bay to catch the ferry to Holyhead, then onwards to your UK destination.
