DAY 10 PENANG

Morning at leisure. Perhaps get away from the busy city to the beach and practice your techniques prior to the match.

Afternoon match followed by after match function.

DAY 11 PENANG

Enjoy a visit to Langkawi, take an interesting boat trip through the Mangrove forest and watch a flock of eagles being fed.

DAY 12 PENANG/ARRIVE HOME

Transfer to the airport for your flight home via Kuala Lumpur.
